## 2020 U.S. Kids Fall Tour Goodwin Park Local Rules

Play is governed by the 2020 Rules of Golf and its interpretations, the U.S. Kids Golf Foundation State Invitational Rules & Regulations, and by the following Local Rules:

- RULES HOTLINE: If during your round you are in need of a ruling or rules official
  assistance, please call the tournament rules hotline at 860-255-4012. Cell phones may
  only be used by a player or caddie to contact the rules hotline or in emergency
  situations, use of cell phones/apps as a distance-measuring device/GPS is prohibited.
- STONES IN BUNKERS: Stones in bunkers are deemed <u>loose impediments</u>, as are leaves, pine cones, and the like. Impediments may be removed from the bunker, however, the removal of the impediment must not cause the ball to move (*Rule 15.1*).
- BUNKERS: Bunkers are defined as sandy areas completely enclosed by sod. If your ball comes to rest in a bunker, the player is permitted to lift, clean, and place their ball within one club length, no closer to the hole. The ball must remain in the bunker. The ball is deemed in play once placed and at rest. The player may smooth the bunker before placing the ball. Please note: this relief option is not available for sandy areas not completely enclosed by sod (waste areas).
- CADDIE STANDING BEHIND LINE OF PLAY (R&A, and USGA Clarification): Therefore, if a
  player takes a stance when the caddie is deliberately standing on or close to an
  extension of the line of play behind the ball, there is no penalty under Rule 10.2b(4) if
  the player backs away from the stance and does not begin to take a stance for the
  stroke that is actually made until after the caddie has moved out of that location. This
  applies anywhere on the course.
- Model Local Rule E-4; "If a player's ball lies in or touches an aeration hole: (a) <u>Ball in General Area</u>. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. If the ball comes to rest in another aeration hole the player may take relief again under this Local Rule.(b) <u>Ball on Putting Green</u>. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1d. But interference does not exist if the aeration hole only interferes with the player's stance or, on the putting green, on the player's line of play.
